SKY CODE	DESCRIPTION
0	Few clouds
1	Partly cloudy (scattered) or variable sky
2	Cloudy (broken) or overcast
4	Fog or smoke
5	Drizzle
7	Snow
8	Showers

Beaufort Wind Scale
0 = CALM: smoke rises vertically.
1 = LIGHT AIR: rising smoke drifts; weather vane inactive
2 = LIGHT BREEZE: leaves rustle; can feel wind on face
3 = GENTLE BREEZE: leaves, twigs in constant motion; small flags extend
4 = MODERATE BREEZE: moves small branches; raises dust and loose paper
5 = FRESH BREEZE: small trees begin to sway; too windy

Call Intensity Index
0 = No frogs or toads can be heard calling
1 = Individuals can be counted; there is space between calls
2 = Calls of individuals can be distinguished but there is some overlapping of calls
3 = Full chorus, calls are constant, continuous and overlapping
